As the Knicks surge in playoffs, see 25 NYC condo and rental buildings with basketball courts

The last March Madness game was over a month ago, but basketball season is still going strong in New York City with the New York Knicks in the NBA Eastern Conference semifinal series. They defeated defending champion Boston Celtics in two games in Boston, and return to Madison Square Garden on Saturday, May 10. If the Knicks win two more games, they will advance to the Eastern finals for the first time since 2000.

Hell Gate calls the Knicks the only sports team that brings the city together, as opposed to divisions between Yankees/Mets and Jets/Giants fans. The excitement shows in ticket prices: ESPN observes that the cheapest resale ticket for Saturday's game is over \$600.

The game will take place on a day with a sunny forecast in the low 70s, one that might have some feeling more inclined to hit the court than sit inside. Basketball courts at the city's parks are likely to fill up fast, but some lucky New Yorkers are well positioned to get in the game: Condos and rentals all over the city count indoor basketball courts among their amenities. And for those who'd rather watch than play, the extensive amenity packages also include lounges with big-screen TVs.
