Residence 8A, a \$5.9 million four-bedroom home, is anchored by a Boffi kitchen that feels both sculptural and inviting. White oak cabinetry contrasts with honed Namibia Rose marble, while large west-facing windows frame the Hudson River in all its moods. Here, every meal is served with a side of sunset.
