Penthouse 17B at 720 West End Avenue

Who says you can't teach an old building new tricks? <u>720 West End Avenue</u> is a 1927 Emery Roth-designed building that's been transformed into a luxury masterpiece thanks to a top-to-bottom renovation by Thomas Juul-Hansen. The result is a chic blend of pre-war charm and modern elegance.



The star of the show is <u>Penthouse 17B</u>, a five-bedroom, five-and-a-half-bathroom corner duplex asking \$11.6 million. It features a whopping 3,493 square feet of interior space, plus a 1,450-square-foot wraparound terrace with panoramic views of the Hudson River and the tree-lined streets of the Upper West Side.

The floor plan is nothing short of genius – there's a grand entry foyer, a sun-drenched great room with a gas fireplace, and a primary wing that's completely separated from the main living areas (perfect for when you need a little peace and quiet). Oh, and did we mention that every single room on the upper level opens onto the terrace? It's like having a private park in the sky.
